

Cleaning Guide

When cleaning please check against the following list:

Kitchen

Walls and ceilings	Dust, remove all cobwebs and wash down.
Cupboards, draws and shelves	Clean all shelves, and wipe down internally and externally
Range hood and filters	Soak in hot soapy water and clean range hood to remove grease. Wipe internally and externally.
Benches	Wash all counter tops and surface areas.
Whitegoods	Clean internally and externally, removing all shelves and washing in hot soapy water.
Stove & Oven	Clean and degrease all cooktop, stove rings, grill, oven and racks.
Windows & Screens	Vacuum all sills, tracks and screens, wash windows, ensuring no streaks or smudges.
Curtains & Blinds	Wash and rehang, wipe down blind blades with damp cloth.
Light fittings & Switches	Wash all shades, wipe all switches with damp cloth.
Light Globes	Replace all blown bulbs
Floors	Sweep /Vacuum all floors, paying particular attention to corners, kickboards and skirting boards.

Bedrooms, Lounge, Dining & Other Rooms

Walls and ceilings	Dust, remove all cobwebs and wash down.
Wardrobes and shelves	Clean all shelves, and wipe down internally and externally
Mirrors, Windows & Screens	Vacuum all sills, tracks and screens, wash windows and mirrors, ensuring no streaks or smudges.
Curtains & Blinds	Wash and rehang, wipe down blind blades with damp cloth.
Light fittings	Wash all shades
Light Globes	Replace all blown bulbs
Floors	Sweep /Vacuum all floors, paying particular attention to corners, kickboards and skirting boards.

Bathrooms, En suites& toilet

Walls and ceilings	Dust, remove all cobwebs and wash down.
Vanity unit & mirror cabinet	Clean all shelves, and wipe down internally and externally
Mirrors, Windows & Screens	Vacuum all sills, tracks and screens, wash windows and mirrors, ensuring no streaks or smudges.
Curtains & Blinds	Wash and rehang, wipe down blind blades with damp cloth.
Light fittings, switches and power points	Wash all shades and remove any bugs from light fixtures Wipe down all switches with damp cloth.
Light Globes	Replace all blown bulbs
Floors	Sweep /Vacuum all floors, paying particular attention to corners, kickboards and skirting boards.
Bath, Shower & Shower screen	Wash shower curtain and/or screen ensuring no soap scum is left in, on or around screen. Remove all body grease off walls and floors, clean soap holder and plug hole.
Sink	Clean and descale sinks and bath taps
Tiles	Clean tiles and grout, removing any mould from walls and grouts.
Toilet	Clean and descale in and around bowl, disinfect, flush and sanitise entire cistern.

Laundry

Walls and ceilings	Dust, remove all cobwebs and wash down.
Whitegoods	Remove filter, clean off lint and dust.
Mirrors, Windows & Screens	Vacuum all sills, tracks and screens, wash windows and mirrors, ensuring no streaks or smudges.
Curtains & Blinds	Wash and rehang, wipe down blind blades with damp cloth.
Light fittings	Wash all shades
Light Globes	Replace all blown bulbs
Floors	Sweep /Vacuum all floors, paying particular attention to corners, kickboards and skirting boards.

Outdoors & General

Lawn	Mow grass, and Whippersnip edges
Garden	Tidy up and weed all garden beds
Pool	Clean out any leaves or debris in pool (check for any special conditions in tenancy agreement)
Garage, Carport & driveways	Remove any oil stains on driveway or in garage. Remove all cobwebs and sweep.
Patio, Balcony & Deck	Sweep external areas and remove all cobwebs
Sheds & Lawn lockers	Clean out, remove all cobwebs and sweep.
Bins	Empty and washout bins. Place all bins on footpath for collection.

Clean the property thoroughly or get a cleaning company to attend for you.

1.	Stove, Oven, element, oven racks, grillers and drip trays	Mr Muscle or Selleys oven cleaner	Follow the instructions as per can. Caustic oven cleaner works faster and most effectively. Spills should be wiped over after use to prevent oven build up. You should do a full clean of the oven every 3 months.
2.	Range hood and Filters	Dishwashing liquid. OVEN CLEANER NOT RECOMMENDED	Soak filters in hot soapy water. Clean range hood to remove build-up of grease.
3.	Cupboards & Drawers	Jif or Ajax spray and wipe	Use scourer to gently clean shelves inside and outside
4.	Bench tops and splashbacks	Jif or Ajax spray and wipe	Clean thoroughly and follow through with dry cloth.
5.	Refrigerator	Vanilla fridge wipe & Dishwashing liquid	Remove all shelves, crisper, racks and wash in soapy water. DON'T CLOSE THE FRIDGE.
6.	Sinks & Taps	Jif	Scrub with cleaner around taps, taps, sinks and sink hole, using an old toothbrush for hard to reach areas.
7.	Tiled floors	Ajax floor cleaner	Mop with boiling water ensuring grout and corners are cleaned.
8.	Bath, shower and Screen	Shower Power or Jif	Spray on and scrub, leave for 30 mins and rinse off.
9.	Toilet	Toilet duck, Domestos or Bleach	Stained toilets pour bleach into bowl, scrub and leave overnight.
10.	Mirrors, Windows and screens.	Windex	Spray and wipe with dry cloth. Vacuum window tracks and screens. Wipe all sills.
11.	Walls, skirting boards, light switches and power points.	Sugar soap, Jif or Spray and wipe	Wipe down walls. Ensuring no scratches or streaks is left on the wall. NOTE: all switches are to be turned off.
12.	Light shades Light bulbs	Dishwashing Liquid	Remove all shades and rinse in soapy water, ensuring they are completely dry before replacing. Replace all blown light bulbs.
13.	Ceiling Fans and	Spray and Wipe	Wipe off dust and dirt. Remove stubborn stains with Jif.
14.	Air cons, washing machine and dryers		Remove filter and clean off lint and dust. Wipe down external of appliance.
